4. First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

Inhalation	Move the victim to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. If breathing has stopped give artificial respiration. Seek immediate medical attention.
Eyes	Check for and remove any contact lenses. Flush eyes with large amounts of lukewarm water for at least 15 minutes. Do not rub or scratch eyes. If symptoms or irritation occur, call a physician.
Skin	Wash with soap and large amounts of tepid water (not to exceed 90°F). Remove and isolate contaminated shoes and clothing. Wash clothing and clean shoes thoroughly before reusing. If symptoms of irritation occur, call a physician.
Ingestion	If swallowed do not induce vomiting and do not give liquids. Rinse mouth with water to remove material from throat. If vomiting occurs spontaneously, keep head below hips to prevent aspiration of liquid into the lungs. Immediately call a physician and seek medical attention.





5. Fire-fighting measures

5.1. Extinguishing media

Class B extinguisher for oil fires, carbon dioxide, dry powder, water fog.

5.2. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

Hazardous decomposition: Oxides of carbon, Sulfur byproducts upon combustion.

Keep cool.

Ground / bond container and receiving equipment.

Use explosion-proof electrical / ventilating / light / equipment.

Use only non-sparking tools.

Take precautionary measures against static discharge.

Do not breathe mist / vapors / spray.

Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

5.3. Advice for fire-fighters

Closed containers may explode in a fire. Keep containers cool and move them to a safe location.

In a confined space, wear positive pressure, self-contained breathing apparatus, (SCBA) with a full face-piece and protective clothing. People without respiratory protection should leave area.

6. Accidental release measures

6.1. Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Put on appropriate personal protective equipment (see section 8).

6.2. Environmental precautions

Do not allow spills to enter drains or waterways.

Use good personal hygiene practices. Wash hands before eating, drinking, smoking or using toilet. Promptly remove soiled clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse.

6.3. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

Pick up large pieces. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. If using dry clean-up procedures (i.e. dry sand), avoid creating dust during clean-up. Wear protective clothing, gloves, safety glasses and a dust respirator. If using liquid cleaners (i.e. mineral spirits or citrus cleaner) pump waste liquid into waste containers, soak up remaining material with absorbent material. Clean contaminated area thoroughly after product recovery, wash the spill area and prevent runoff into drains. Waste should be disposed of in accordance with state, local and federal regulations.





7. Handling and storage

7.1. Precautions for safe handling

Always ground the containers when transferring or mixing. Avoid direct contact, avoid breathing vapors or mist and avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing.

7.2. Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities

Store in cool, dry area, away from heat, sparks and naked flames.

Keep containers sealed when not in use.

Keep container closed when not in use. Store in a dry ventilated area. Maintain package labeling during storage.

Incompatible materials: Can react violently with strong oxidizing agents, alkalis and acids.

Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep away from direct sunlight, high heat, incompatible materials and any sources of ignition.

8.2. Exposure Controls



Respiratory

Avoid breathing the vapor. Use an organic vapor mask under normal conditions and use a NIOSH/OSHA approved organic vapor canister respirator when exposure levels are exceeded.

Use adequate ventilation. Engineering: provide sufficient ventilation to control the exposure levels below limits.

Eyes

Wear anti-splash chemical goggles with side shields or wear a full-face shield.

Contact lenses should not be worn.

Skin

Protective clothing is necessary to prevent the wetting of skin.

Engineering Controls

Provide adequate ventilation. Where reasonably practicable this should be achieved by the use of local exhaust ventilation and good general extraction. If these are not sufficient to maintain concentrations of particulates and any vapor below occupational exposure limits suitable respiratory protection must be worn.

Other Work Practices

Avoid repeated or prolonged contact with the skin. If rags are used with this product as a cleaning purpose, discard them into a water-filled container after use. Use good personal hygiene practices. Wash hands before eating, drinking, smoking or using toilet. Promptly remove soiled clothing and wash thoroughly before reuse.
